Department of State DoS), Diplomatic Security Training Center/Foreign Affairs Training Center (\$200M):

All Native provides a curriculum of specialized training to hundreds of Government employees including diplomatic security agents and other State Department staff in advance of global placement. We provide onsite assessment and training follow-up (OCONUS). Training includes security driving, firearms, special-skills tactics, medical, and explosive counter measures, and high-threat post personnel training. ANG provides security and law enforcement training, supports course coordination and provides subject matter expertise for the development, instruction, and delivery of a multitude of training areas to include instructional systems support. We provide security engineering and computer security training courses to include cyber security, technical security, information assurance, Technical Surveillance Countermeasures, Technical Security Systems and Procedures, construction Security/Surveillance, and Information System Security. Cyber Security Courses include ISSO Cyber Security Foundations, Systems Administrator Cyber Security Foundations, Information Assurance for Managers, Information Assurance for System Owners, Information Assurance/Executive, Software Assurance for Application Programmers, DOS RMF/Authorization Process Introduction, and ISCP for System Owners.

Department of State (DoS) Foreign Service Institute IT and Cybersecurity Training IDIQ (\$25M): On multiple, consecutive contracts ANG has provided the Department of State (DOS) employees training via the School of Applied Information Technology (SAIT). We provide complete training support services for SAIT’s IT and Cybersecurity Training. Our information assurance staff provide Instructional Design, Curriculum Development, Classroom Instruction, and Just-in- Time Cybersecurity related training to State Department personnel. Courses are via Instructor-Led, Asynchronous, Hybrid, Virtual training, Webinars, Podcasts, and IA Workshops. We provide training services at various other DOS locations, both domestic and overseas.

Our Just-In-Time Training via the FSI TechTalks (FTT) Cybersecurity Webinars Series program provides critical training focusing on Cybersecurity, Information Security, and IT Risk Management at the DoS. The FTT Program proved to be invaluable in providing critical training platform in response to Office of Inspector General findings on the need to improve the DOS Cyber Training posture. We managed the FTT program and produced 58 training sessions for more than 5,000 participants, 29 webinars and 13 on demand videos.

DoS Security Engineering and Computer Division (SECD) Training Services (\$6M): ANG supports the DoS Bureau of Diplomatic Security (DS) in its mission to protect U.S. personnel, official facilities and residences domestic and overseas at 260 Foreign Service posts worldwide. We provide specialized security training for DS and other DOS employees, foreign affairs agencies, and support training activities for certain foreign government security and law enforcement personnel.

This includes conducting formal instruction and briefings, providing personnel, managing resources, writing training policies, and providing analysis, development, and evaluation to support standardization and accreditation of applicable Foreign Affairs Security training programs. In addition to operational and advisory training support, we deliver facility and logistics and IT support services. Management support includes staffing, reporting, contract administration, financial and budgeting support, procurement support, curriculum development, course material management, technical writing and material development.

DoS, Training Management System (TMS): On the TMS program, ANG provides traditional written assessments and online tests, thus maintaining a complete and detailed training record for both the agency and the individual employee. In addition, the software automates and integrates costly standalone operational functions, such as scheduling, registration, housing, certification, and document management into an enterprise framework.
